Electricity switched off? Here's how you prevent this from happening!

## Why does electricity get switched off?

- 1. If you want to reduce your monthly advance payment or if you do not pay the additional payment from the annual consumption bill, the electricity provider will send you a reminder.
- 2. If you do not pay thereafter and the amount you owe for electricity is higher than € 100, the supplier will send you a reminder with a warning, that your electricity will be switched off. This means: In about 4 weeks, your electricity will be switched off, if you do not pay.
- 3. If you still haven't paid, the provider will send you a notice confirming a switch-off. This means: In 8 days, your electricity will be switched off!

## What can you do?

If you were unable to pay your bills, talk to your electricity provider and explain why you couldn't pay.

## Ask for an instalment payment.

- 1. The instalment amount may only be so high, that you can also pay the instalment.
- 2. Always transfer the instalment and the advance payment *separately* to the provider's account.
- 3. Enter either "electricity advance payment" or "instalment payment" as the reason for payment.

## Also ask the Jobcenter or social welfare office for financial support.

Electricity debts can also be taken over as a loan, even if you do not receive social benefits.
